- [Is there a recommended length for the video?](#)

All submissions must include a video link, or the submission will not be considered. This video does not need to be from a live course and can be a self-recording to demonstrate your skills as a speaker. The content of the video does not have to be on the topic you are submitting, but it does help. It is recommended to edit the clip of your best content within a 1–2-minute timeframe.

- [What format are the conference sessions?](#)

There are multiple format options available to select for your proposal: case study, group discussion, lecture, panel discussion, roundtable, workshop, field experience, facilitated networking.

- [Is there a limit on how many proposals I can submit?](#)

You can submit up to six (6) different proposals.

- [What are some examples of things you are looking for 2022?](#)

Submissions directly related to handling unique aspects of current market conditions, sessions that incorporate the 2022 Strategic Priorities, managing teams effectively, new technology, multi-market selling – resort and second homes, managing your business at an agent and broker level, etc.

- [What are the biggest mistakes you see speakers make when submitting their proposals?](#)

Not including a video with the submission and making sure the video is a short clip of your best content.

Not being clear enough with what you want to accomplish with your content – including title and key takeaways.

- [Is being an NAR member a requirement to speak at the conference?](#)

NAR Membership is not a requirement to be a speaker. Non-industry and non-member speakers are welcome to submit a proposal.

- [What is the timeline for the selection process?](#)

The deadline to submit a proposal is Tuesday, January 11. After that date, the review process will take place over the next 6-8 weeks. Acceptances will be sent out sometime in mid- to late-May.

- [How do I submit a proposal for another NAR event outside of the conference?](#)

The Conference & Expo is the only meeting that officially accepts call for proposals, besides AE Institute. However, in the call for proposals application there is a list of other events hosted by NAR that can be checked if you are interested in presenting there. If applicable, your proposal will be shared accordingly.
